### Mentor Expectations:

Must be willing to make an eight months commitment, from October 2018 to May 2019, to meet with their student match at least twice a month after school or on weekends.

- Must attend a mandatory training and participate in LAA activities when possible.
- Must maintain contact with mentees parents.
- Must schedule at least two meetings a month with their student.
- Must work closely with program staff to provide activity logs, updates, and feedback.
- Must maintain communication with mentee and follow through on commitments.
- Must serve as a resource and source of support for their mentee.
