Must be willing to make a 8 month commitment, from September 2019 to May 2020, to meet with their student match at twice a month after school or on weekends.

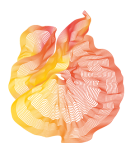
- Must be 20 years or older.
- Must attend mandatory training and participate in the LAA activities when possible.
- Must maintain contact with mentees parents.
- Must schedule at least two meetings a month with their mentee.
- Must work closely with program staff to provide activity logs, updates, and feedback.
- Must maintain communication with mentee and follow through on commitments.
