Organizational impact Served 44.521 individuals

Impact by department:

Family Well-Being:

Met the basic needs of 6,423 unique households, impacting 24,903 low-income Latino men. women, and children, and provided over \$103,000 in emergency financial assistance.



Economic Empowerment:

Served over 1,100 aspiring female entrepreneurs through our Latina Leadership Institute, 369 through financial readiness and job training classes, and 800 through the Latina Empowerment Conference.



Immigration:

Provided culturally responsive legal services to over 2,400 individual clients, including 115 survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault.



Advocacy:

Began new partnership with the City of Brookhaven to improve Brookhaven's outreach and engagement with its Latino residents along Buford Highway.



Education:

Held La Feria de Educación, connecting over 1,500 Latino families across metro Atlanta to educational resources, supplies, and information at the beginning of the school year.
